

## REQUEST FOR PRINT DISABILITY SERVICES

Persons who are unable to read traditional print due to a visual, physical or learning disability can apply for Print Disability services. This service is added to your library account and allows you to borrow DAISY books and to access these services:

- NNELS: an online library of books in accessible formats, including DAISY, PDF and e-text.
- **CELA:** reading material in accessible formats (e-text, Braille, audio and more) through online access and home delivery.
- **Staff Selection:** Millennium Library's Special Services can select audiobooks, DAISY books and Large Print books based on reading preferences and have them sent for pick-up at any branch of Winnipeg Public Library.

To be eligible you must be unable to read traditional print due to a learning, physical or visual disability, in accordance with the Canadian Copyright Act.

- Learning Disability: an impairment relating to comprehension.
- Physical Disability: the inability to hold or manipulate a book.
- Visual Disability: the severe or total impairment of sight or the inability to focus or move one's eyes.

A print disability does not include reading difficulties from low literacy levels.
