**Criteria:** The successful applicant must have had at least two books published professionally as well as previous experience in teaching, mentoring or as a manuscript evaluator or editor. Preference will be given to Manitoba residents.

**Application:** Your letter of application must include the following:

- Your history of literary publications in poetry, drama, fiction or nonfiction
- A statement on your personal mentoring philosophy
- Your experience in developing and delivering writing or editing courses, workshops, etc.
- Description of the personal writing project to be worked on during the residency
- Proposal for at least one public program or workshop to be offered during the residency, with special attention to distance programming via Zoom, streaming or conferencing platforms.
- References from a literary colleague (e.g. writer, publisher) and from an individual or organization you have provided mentorship to.
