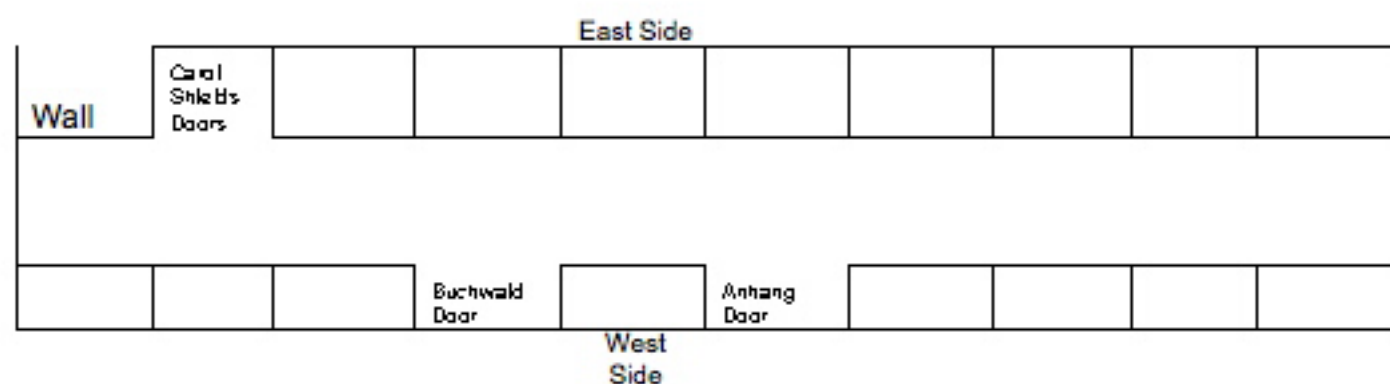


Blankstein Art Gallery and Exhibit Space Information Millennium Library, Second floor

- There are 16 locked glass cabinets.
- There are 8 cabinets on the east side, lining the hallway side by side ending at the Carol Shields Auditorium doors.
- There are 8 cabinets on the west side; 4 together then the Anhang door, 1 cabinet alone, then the Buchwald door, then 3 together ending at the Skywalk wall.

- Each cabinet is 58" wide, by 64" high by 9.5" deep.
- Each cabinet has 2 glass doors that lock.
- The cabinets are backed by tack board to accept picture hangers or nails or tacks.
Picture Hanging hooks work best for framed or heavier items.
- Double-sided tape does not hold well as it dries out in the library very quickly. Velcro has been used successfully by stapling into the tack board.
- The 4 cabinets on the east side closest to the Library doors have a cable for hanging items.
- Please bring your items ready to hang and the hanging materials appropriate for the items.
- There is a double-sided signboard for information about the artist, group or exhibit available for use.
- It is free standing, and is a standard poster size 22" x 27.5".
