Library Advisory Committees

Helping improve library services
in your community

What is a Library Advisory Committee?

Library Advisory Committees (LACs) are located in five areas of the City to advise and report to the Winnipeg Public Library Board on library services within that area.

Area	Branches
Assiniboia:	Charleswood, St. James-Assiniboia and Westwood
City Centre:	Cornish, Fort Garry, Osborne, River Heights and West End
East Kildonan-Transcona:	Henderson, Munroe and Transcona
Lord Selkirk-West Kildonan:	St. John's, Sir William Stephenson and West Kildonan
Riel:	Louis Riel, Pembina Trail, St. Boniface, St. Vital and Windsor Park

Each LAC is composed of:

- 6 citizens from the Community (appointed by City Council's local Community Committee)
- 2 members of the Winnipeg Public Library Board
- 1 Library Administrative Representative

What do they do?

In conjunction with the Winnipeg Public Library and the Library Board, LACs undertake special projects, identify and convey library matters of local interest, gather community feedback, participate in various Library events and support the library system.

LACs meet at least three times a year at the call of the Chair.

How can I become a member of a LAC?

A citizen can apply to be a member of the LAC in their area on an annual basis. Term appointments to LACs are for two years, to a maximum of three consecutive terms.

Canadian citizens who reside in Winnipeg are eligible to apply. Aboriginal peoples, women, visible minorities and individuals with disabilities are encouraged to apply.

How do I receive more information?

During the usual application period (between the end of September and the third week of November each year), go to the City Clerk's Department at winnipeg.ca/clerks/docs/boards/boardapp.stm, and apply online or print a PDF application form. Or pick up an application form at your local branch.
