### What does the Library Advisory Committee do?

Library Advisory Committee (LAC) members are appointed by Community Committees (local City Councillors) to advise and report to the Winnipeg Public Library Board on library services within the community. Each LAC has six citizen members, two members from the



Library Board, and a Library staff representative.

In conjunction with the Library and the Library Board, LACs undertake special projects, identify and convey library matters of local interest, gather community feedback and support the library system.

### Time commitment:

4 – 6 evening meetings per year, at a local library, as well as two special meetings.

### How do I join the Library Advisory Committee?

The City of Winnipeg has invited citizens to apply for its boards and commissions. Application forms for 2012 are now available. Term appointments to Library Advisory Committees are for two years, to a maximum of three terms.

The application deadline is **November 11, 2011\***. Appointments are usually made in December.
