2. Recruitment Update

3. Report Updates

 Improving Safety at Millennium Library and Other Winnipeg Public Libraries – Heard by Council July 13, 2023

Funding Referral to the 2024-2027 Budget – That the operating budget requirement of \$2,434,000 annually be referred to the 2024-2027 multi-year budget process as follows:

- a) To continue to provide enhanced safety and security improvements at Winnipeg Public Library described in Recommendation 1, namely 10 community safety hosts, Increased complement of contracted security guards, library employee training (\$1,820,000 annually); and
- b) To continue to staff (4.2 FTEs) and 2 Community Safety Hosts to operate the Community Connections space at Millennium Library as described in Recommendation 2 (\$614,000 annually).

 Review of Library Services Division Services for Improvement and Investment – Heard by Council November 23, 2023 recommendations are being referred to the 2024-2027 budget

Funding Referral to the 2024-2027 Budget – The report recommends referral to the 2024-2027 multi-year budget process an incremental increase of 12.41 FTEs, additional mill rate support of \$2,042,131 in 2024, \$2,523,974 in 2025, \$3,006,453 in 2026 and \$3,489,582 in 2027, and increased capital investment of \$502,000 in 2024.

4. Winnipeg Public Library App

5. Youth Services Update

- The Fall Early Literacy Session (September 18 November 10) has finished. It included 497 early literacy programs (Baby Rhyme Time, Toddler Time, Family Story Time, Sensory Story Time) and 9,720 children and caregivers attended.
- The Winter Early Literacy Session will run January 22 March 16, with registration opening December 11. It will include 552 early literacy programs (Baby Rhyme Time, Toddler Time, Family Story Time, Sensory Story Time).
- On October 21st, November 4th, and November 18th, local comic author GMB Chomichuk held a series of teen comic workshops at the Millennium Library with a total of 35 teens in attendance over the three sessions.
- World Language Story Times in Ukrainian, Filipino, and Spanish took place in November at the Harvey Smith, West Kildonan, Charleswood, St. John's and Louis Riel Library branches. A total of 95 people attended these programs, and there were many positive comments on the program evaluation forms about how much the attendees enjoyed being able to hear stories in their language at the library. Many thanks to the Library Board for their support of these programs.

7. Marketing Update

Thank you to the Board for the \$1,000 funding towards sponsored social media ads for September, October, and November 2023. The additional funds from the Board allowed us to focus on promoting targeted programs; a strategy that is not normally feasible within our budget.

Facebook has been changing the algorithm that determines what content appears across a user's feeds. It is becoming increasingly difficult to have organic content appear on feeds without paying for sponsored ads. The algorithm feeds on meaningful interactions- so the more interactions you get on your page, the more content appears across a follower's feeds. By paying for sponsored ads, we have a greater likelihood of having our paid ad show up on our followers' feeds, having some interaction, leading to future content showing up on feeds.

Reach and impressions are two different metrics used to measure the exposure of ads on social media. Reach is the total number of unique people who see the ad, while impressions are the number of times the ad is displayed, regardless of whether it was clicked or not. Impressions are usually higher because one person can see the same ad multiple times.

Program results:

Programs with sponsored ads saw success both in numbers and an engaged audience. The Red Dress pin program attendance was: October 21- 1 person, October 23-16 people, October 26-17 people, November 2- 19 people. Sponsored ad promotion began after the first event date. The audience was a great mix of teens, adults, Indigenous and non-Indigenous people.

Sponsored ads helped fill spots for Science Literacy Week, We Dig Dinos and Teen Comic Workshop. For children's/youth programs, sponsored ads tend to help with programming that happens at more than one branch (spring break or Science Literacy Week) and teen programs.
