The Local History Room is located on the 4th floor of Millennium Library.

The Local History Room has a unique collection of resources devoted to the history of Winnipeg and Manitoba. All items are reference only with scanners, copiers and staff to help with visitors' research needs.

Highlights of the Local History Room include histories of Winnipeg and Manitoba communities, Métis and Riel Rebellion histories, local genealogy resources such as newspaper archives, Winnipeg city directories, and rare novels of local authors.
