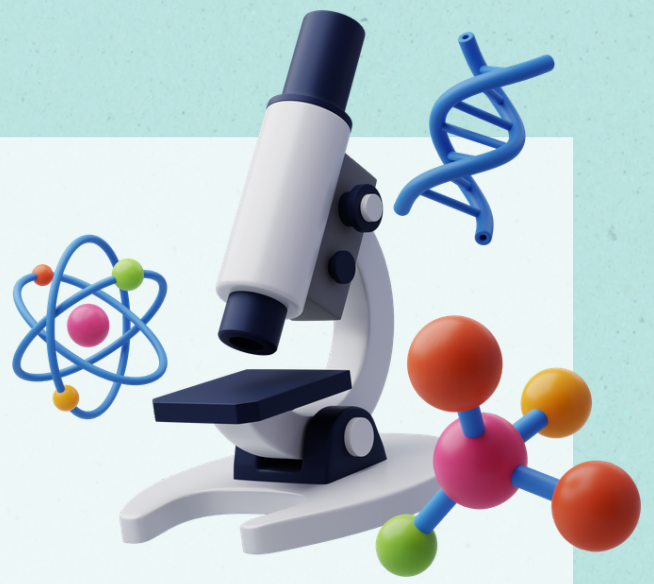


Science Programs for Kids
