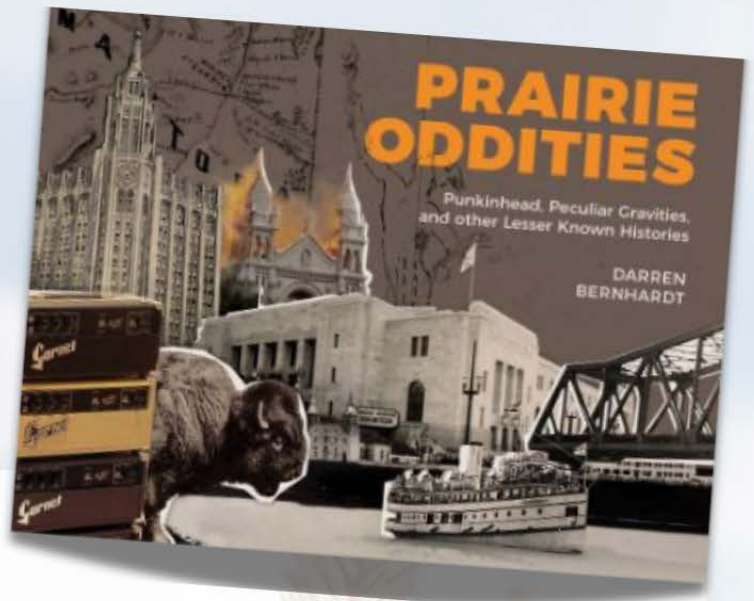


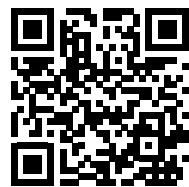
# Prairie Oddities
