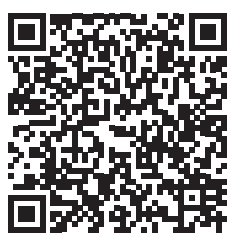


You're invited to join

3. Include an attached sample of your work (max. 2 pages) as a PDF or Word document so we have an idea of where everyone is in their writing process.
4. Answer this question: What do you hope to get out of the writing circle?

The application deadline is November 21, 2025. Successful applicants will be notified by the end of November, and the first meeting will be Tuesday, December 16th: 6-7:30 p.m.
