<b>Monday, Dec. 1</b> <b>11 a.m. - 2 p.m.</b> 2nd Floor	<b>Info Table: Legal Help Centre</b> Drop by and talk to staff about their free legal clinics, workshops and other services. Find out if you qualify and what services may be available to you.
<b>Tuesday, Dec. 2</b> <b>11 a.m. - 1 p.m.</b> 2nd Floor	<b>WRHA Public Health, Healthy Sexuality and Harm Reduction</b> Meet with a public health nurse for health supports, immunizations, and vaccine records. They can also help you find a family doctor and get connected to prenatal health care, home care, and community mental health supports. Ask staff about harm reduction programming, and STBBI testing and treatment services.
<b>Wednesday, Dec. 3</b> <b>1 - 4 p.m.</b> Buchwald Room, 2nd Floor	<b>CRA, Service Canada, and Sara Riel Drop-in Clinic</b> Drop in to this clinic for help with a variety of government services on a first-come, first-served basis. Ask about accessing your CRA and Service Canada online accounts, get a copy of your option C, get information about the Canada Child Tax Benefit, EI and EIA benefits and more. Sara Riel's Peer Navigators support individuals in accessing resources and services to build stability and find permanent housing.
<b>Thursday, Dec. 4</b> <b>11 a.m. - 2 p.m.</b> Lobby, Main Floor	<b>Info Table: Community Unemployed Help Centre</b> Community Unemployed Help Centre provides information, assistance, advice and representation for individuals dealing with EI or EIA. Drop by to learn more.
