CRA staff can help with:

- Personal income tax questions
- Address and direct deposit changes
- CRA online account access
- Proof of Income statement (Option C)
- Notice of Assessment
- Canada Child Benefit (CCB)
- Canada Groceries and Essentials Benefit (CGEB)
- Disability Tax Credit (DTC)
