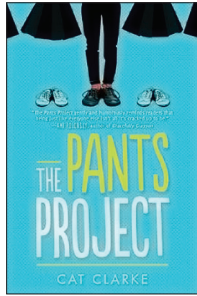

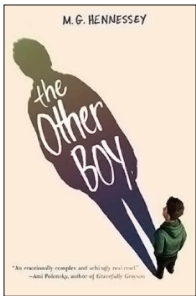
The Pants Project by Cat Clarke J FICTION CLARKE

The Other Boy by M. G. Hennessey J FICTION HENNESSEY

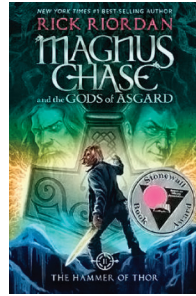

Grayson, a transgender twelve-year-old, learns to accept her true identity and share it with the world. (2014)

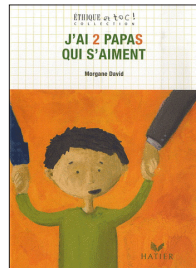
Magnus Chase and the Gods of Asgard: The Hammer of Thor by Rick Riordan J FICTION RIORDAN

Join Sadie and Amira, two very different princesses with very different strengths, on their journey to figure out what happily ever after really means -- and how they can find it with each other. (2016)

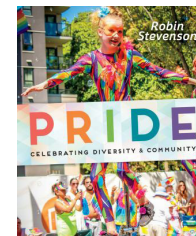
Drama FR by Raina Telgemeier J GRAPHIC FICTION TELGEMEIER
